Urological Cancer.

Prostate cancer diagnosis and treatment. Initial evaluation of abnormal PSA test results, transrectal ultrasound and prostate biopsy and interpretation of abnormal biopsy results. Prostate cancer treatments including da vinci robot assisted radical prostatectomy, prostate brachytherapy (prostate seeds or rods) and HIFU (high intensity focused ultrasound).

Counselling men with prostate cancer regarding treatment options and evidence based outcomes, including a second opinion.

Bladder cancer treatment with endoscopic surgery and bladder immunotherapy.

Radical bladder cancer surgery with urinary diversion or neobladder reconstruction.

Kidney Cancer treatment with open or laparoscopic surgery.

Testicular cancer using international treatment protocols.
